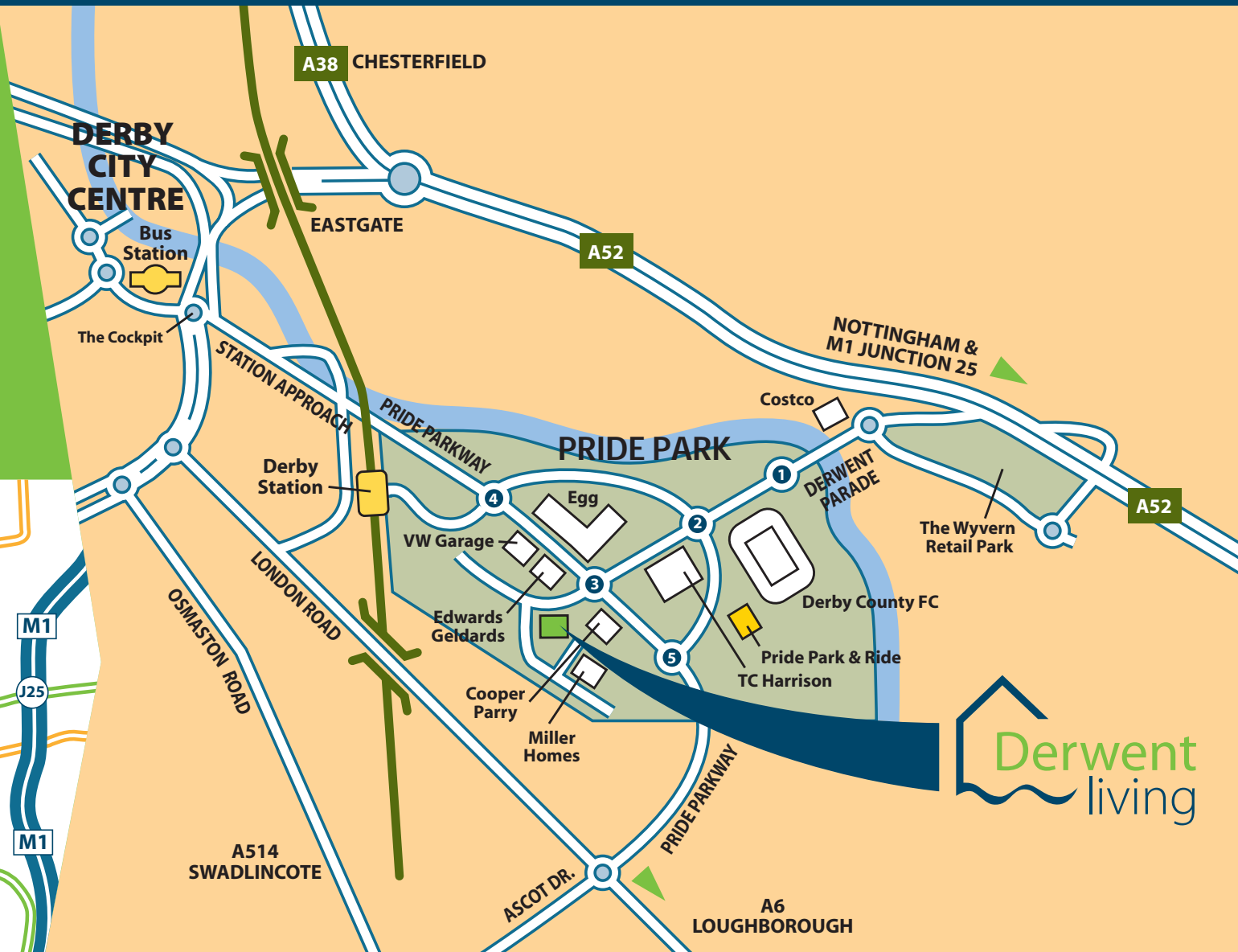
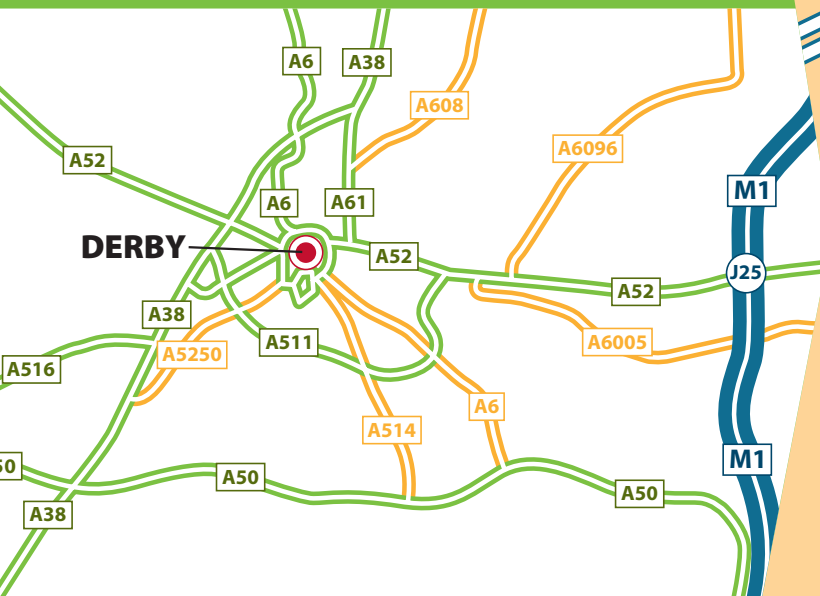

From the M1

Exit the M1 motorway at Junction 25 (signed Nottingham, Derby, Ilkeston and A52). Follow the A52 for approx. 6 miles towards Derby.

Continue through the junction with the A5111 and take the next slip road exit signposted to Pride Park.

Continue straight over the roundabouts numbered 1, 2 and 3 and take the first left after roundabout 3 into Centro Place.

Drive around the back of the building where parking can be found at the side of the building.

From M6

From the M6 junction 15 or 16, follow the A500 towards Stoke.

Remain on the A500 to the A50 exit for Derby and the M1.

Join the A50 and continue for 27.3 miles following signs for Derby.

Join the A38 and continue for 6.2 miles to the roundabout junction with the A52.

Turn right and proceed along Ashbourne Road.

Turn left into Bridge Street and follow the road right onto Agard Street which leads onto St Alkmunds's Way.

Continue straight over The Pentagon roundabout (A52), and take the next slip road exit, signposted Pride Park.

At the roundabout take the second exit, and take the first exit at the next roundabout onto Derwent Parade.

Continue straight over the roundabouts numbered 1, 2 and 3 and take the first left after roundabout 3 into Centro Place.

Drive around the back of the building where parking can be found at the side of the building.

By rail

The nearest station is Derby which is a ten minute walk from Centro Place. Follow signs for Pride Park on your exit.

By bus

The Pride Park shuttle runs every 12 minutes from 7am –7pm from bay 29 of the bus station. The nearest bus stop is outside the Edwards Geldard building, approx 100 yards from Derwent Living.

Arriva Buses operate services to and from Derby city centre every 15 minutes. This travels from the bus station to the Pride Park and Ride

Parking
